Software Engineer: Software Engineer I

Designs, develops, documents, tests and debugs applications software and systems that contain logical and mathematical solutions. Conducts multidisciplinary research and collaborates with equipment designers and/or hardware engineers in the planning, design, development and utilization of electronic data processing systems for product and commercial software. Determines computer user needs; analyzes system capabilities to resolve problems on program intent, output requirements, input data acquisition, programming techniques and controls; prepares operating instructions; designs and develops compilers and assemblers, utility programs, and operating systems. Ensures software standards are met.

Discretion/Latitude

Work is closely supervised. Follows specific, detailed instructions and/or guidance from more senior functional staff.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

Limited use and/or application of basic technical principles, theories and concepts to specific job assignments.

Problem Solving

Develops solutions to routine technical problems of limited scope by following standardized practices and procedures.

Impact

Contributes to the completion of routine technical tasks. Failure to achieve results can normally be overcome without serious effect on schedules and programs.

Liason

Contacts are primarily with immediate supervisor, project leaders, and other professionals in the section or group.

Minimum Education and Experience
