Financial Planning and Analysis Management: Supervisor, Financial Planning & Analysis

Participates in the preparation of budgets and schedules for all contract work and performs and/or assists in financial analyses such as funding profiles, sales outlook, and variance analysis. Performs analyses and prepares reports in order to ensure that contracts are within negotiated and agreed-upon parameters and government cost control guidelines. Ensures adequate funding availability by maintaining accurate records of expenditures, directing preparation of expenditure projections, and submitting timely requests for additional funding to the government. Incorporates contractual changes into control systems by staying aware of outstanding work against each contract in order to maintain realistic contract cost and schedule baselines. Participates in the control of costs and schedules on contracts requiring validated cost schedule control system. Prepares the pricing information for government and commercial estimates and proposals.

Management Role

Accomplishes tasks mainly through direct supervision of non-exempt and entry-level exempt employees.

Policy and Strategy

Directs daily operations of work area.

Freedom to Act

Assignments are largely established in accordance with schedules and deliverables. Work is reviewed for accuracy and completeness.

Impact

Decisions have a direct impact on work unit operations. Erroneous decisions or recommendations or failure to achieve results might cause delays in schedules.

Liaison

Interacts daily with subordinates and/or peers within similar and/or related functions primarily for the purpose of presenting and exchanging information.

Minimum Education and Experience

Bachelor's Degree in Finance, Business or related field and 5+ years of diverse professional experience in all areas of Finance which may include 1+ years previous lead or supervisory responsibilities.
